Directions from Boston Logan Airport to Senior Aerospace Metal Bellows

- Take I-93 South (also called Southeast Expressway & Route 3 South) via Sumner Tunnel
- Follow Signs to the Expressway South / I-93 South / 3 South
- Stay on I-93 South as Route 3 splits off to the left (after I-93 and Rte 3 splits, the road becomes I-93 Rte 128)
- Take I-95 South
- Take Exit 9, "Rte 1 South, Wrentham" (this will put you on Rte1 South)
- Go through the first traffic light
- Senior Aerospace is approximately 1/4 mile past the lights on the right (you will see a small white sign with our name on it to the left of our driveway)

1. Exit airport
2. Follow signs to Sumner Tunnel
3. Take 93 South to 95 and 128 (Providence/Dedham)
4. Take Exit 9 South to Rt. 1 South (Wrentham)
5. Follow Route 1 South and cross Old Post Road.
6. The facility is approx. 300 yards past Old Post Road on the right
