## Senior receives prestigious low-carbon award from Safran

Senior plc (“Senior”), an international manufacturer of high technology components and systems, announces that it has received a prestigious award from Safran SA (“Safran”), an international high-technology group, operating in the aviation (propulsion, equipment and interiors), defence and space markets, that recognises Senior’s commitment to decarbonisation and sustainability, which is rooted in the Company’s core values and underpins its purpose.

In recognition of its decarbonisation efforts, Senior was invited to enter the “Safran IP Challenge 2024”. The competition showcases Safran suppliers that are implementing decarbonisation initiatives, and therefore supporting Safran’s own actions to reduce its carbon footprint.

The Senior Aerospace Thailand team implemented a method of harvesting exhaust air flow from a factory air conditioning system to generate enough electricity to power two manufacturing cells and battery charging for an electric car. It is estimated that the use of the system during 2024 and beyond will reduce greenhouse gas emissions by between 100 – 200 tonnes per annum.

The award, presented by Nathalie Stubler, Safran Chief Sustainability Officer, at a ceremony at Safran’s headquarters in Massy, France, was received by representatives from Senior.
